

Sea Lily (Crinoidea)

Crinoids are marine animal, called as 'lily' due to their adult form which refers to lily flower. They live in shallow water and in depths as great as 6000 meters. Crinoids are usually attached to the sea bottom, if it impossible to get their foot, they will live in the more suitable and comfort area. Sea lily has branched arms with various colors, green, yellow, red, black, or the mixture of two or more colors. Their main food is plankton and fish larva. This animal lived in Sangiran, when Sangiran was a marine environment.



Rugosa

Rugosa is often referred to as horn coral due to its shape and characteristics which imitates the horn and its wrinkle, or rugose wall. Rugosa can live in a group (large colonies) or live alone. The solitary rugosans can reach nearly 1 meter in length. This rugosa live in sea bottom or in dead coral. Like other coral, rugosa is also important to construct coral reef.
